



Community Spay/Neuter Program for DOGS

Thank you for your interest in our low cost, Community Spay/Neuter Program! Getting your personal pets spayed or neutered is the most effective solution to the overpopulation problem in Montgomery County, TX.

We offer two Spay/Neuter programs for DOGS.

*If your dog already has had some vaccinations, bring current vaccination records with you on the day of surgery. You MUST provide proof of current rabies vaccination or you will be charge \$10 to receive one.

1. Plan A

Eligibility Requirements:

- a. Proof of being a recipient of Medicaid or Medicare, Unemployment, Supplemental Security Income Program, EBT Card or WIC or have an income of \$40,000 a year or less.
- b. Proof of Montgomery County residency such as a driver's license or current electricity bill.
- c. Dog must be at least 3 months old.
- d. Limited to three (3) dogs per household per calendar year.

Required Costs:

\$30.00 Per animal male or female which includes: Spay or neuter of the animal and a pain management injection that lasts 24 - 48 hours.

\$10.00 for a rabies vaccination if your dog does not have one. Rabies vaccinations are required by law in Texas by 4 months of age, and required when spaying or neutering. Rabies vaccination may be given at three (3) months of age.

\$10.00 additional for females who are determined to be in heat at the time of surgery with payment required at checkout.

\$35.00 additional for females who are determined to be in late term pregnancy at the time of surgery with payment required at checkout.

\$75.00 additional for males who are determined to have undescended testicles at the time of surgery with payment required at checkout.

\$7.00 additional for any animal with fleas at the time of surgery with payment required at checkout

Recommended:

\$15.00 – DHLPP/Distemper vaccination – recommended annually to prevent distemper – a disease that can cause neurological damage and sometimes death.

\$65.00 – For pre-anesthesia bloodwork highly recommended for dogs over 10 years of age.

\$20.00 – Heartworm Test - checks for heartworms which can be an expensive problem to treat.

\$35.00 – Microchip - to increase the chances of your animal being returned to you if lost.

2. Plan B

Eligibility Requirements:

- a. Open to anyone who cannot afford to pay for Spay/Neuter through a regular vet and do not qualify for Plan A.
- b. Proof of Montgomery County residency such as a driver's license or current electricity bill.
- c. Dog must be at least 3 months old.

- d. Limited to three (3) dogs per household per calendar year.

Required Costs:

\$80.00 Per animal male or female which includes: Spay or neuter of the animal and a pain management injection that lasts 24 - 48 hours.

-- All other costs are the same as Plan A above. --

To apply for either program:

- Go to www.operationpetsalive.org, Click on "Programs", Scroll down to "Targeted Spay/Neuter" section, click on "Click here for Application form"
- Print form, complete, then scan or take a picture of it and email to: spayneuter@operationpetsalive.org *This is the preferred and quickest way.
- You can also complete the application then mail it to the address below along with the appropriate fee including the rabies fee of \$10.00 if your dog does not have one. Include payment for any other vaccinations needed and any additional applicable fees.
